- B. ONLY LANE COUNTY RESIDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW/EXHIBIT/SELL IN THE CAVY DEPARTMENT.
- C. All Cavies must be ARBA Approved Tagged and this number listed online. If your Cavy needs to be tagged, the Superintendent will do it for you on Sunday, August 12. The charge will be \$1.50 per animal. Ear number substitution in same class, same sex will be allowed only until THURSDAY, AUGUST 9, 12:00 NOON. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS AFTER THAT TIME. Call the Fair Office, 682-7338, with ear number substitutions.
- D. The sales will be handled through the Superintendent; please pick up sales forms when placing animals. Only pedigreed animals entered or on exhibit in the cavy barn may be sold. There will be a \$0.50 handling fee on any animal sold. Please give pedigree and completed sales forms to the Superintendent. You will be issued a receipt for all animals sold with your sale price.
- E. All entries will be released Sunday, August 19th. The time to be announced at a later date.
- F. Online entry deadline is July 27th, at 6 pm.
- G. Exhibit entries will be accepted online only through our Fair Website. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries through the online program will be made available at the Fairgrounds in June and July. There is a \$3.00 transaction Fee per exhibitor to enter your entries. To Enter Contest: You must list this entry online. Enter Section 848 Class 1, listing "Costume Contest" in the breed blank-animals disqualified in the open show are still eligible for this contest. You will receive an admission pass to come in on Tuesday night when you check-in with your animals on Sunday.
