## JUDGING: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 15TH AT 11AM

- A. Entry Fees: \$12.00 per head. Entries close Friday, July 27, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries through the online program will be made available at the fairgrounds on the following dates:
- June 20th, 12-6 pm
  - June 30th, 10-4 pm
  - July 11th, 12-6 pm
  - July 27th, 8-6 pm
- There is a \$3.00 fee per exhibitor to enter online and at the labs.  
Premiums will be paid out “in cash” during Fair week– dates and times will be available on entry date.
- B. Entries must be in place Monday, August 13, 2007 by 10:00 p.m.
- C. ALL CATTLE MUST BE DOUBLE TIED!
- D. All Cattle are to be judged in designated show ring, Livestock Pavilion.
- E. PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE NO MILKING FACILITIES AVAILABLE.
- F. The Lane County Fair Cattle Departments are open to all Exhibitors that reside in Oregon. Entries limited to 150 head. First consideration given to Lane County residents.
- G. **ALL PENS AND/OR STALLS MUST BE CLEAN AND READY FOR PUBLIC NO LATER THAN 10:00 A.M. VIOLATORS WILL FORFEIT ANY AND ALL PREMIUMS.**
- H. Animals must be attended to throughout the day-Stalls cleaned, animals fed & watered, Calves Nursed, Tack & Display must be clean & presentable. Failure to follow these rules will result in loss of premiums & animal will be sent home.

- C. NO ANIMAL SHALL COMPETE IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS.
- D. ALL CATTLE MUST BE DOUBLE TIED! Bulls over 1 year old must be shown with nose-ring.
- E. Heifers to be no older than (September 1, 2005).
- F. Bulls to be no older than (January 1, 2005).
- G. All Breeds to be shown together.
- H. No uniform required. Appropriate show attire required.
- I. The Show/Fair Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
- J. The Emerald Valley Jackpot is open to all exhibitors that reside in Oregon.
