JUDGING: MONDAY AUGUST 13TH AT 9:00 AM

WHEN ENTERING ONLINE, USE THE FIELD "ANIMAL NAME" TO ENTER THE BREED. USE THE FIELD "REGISTRY NUMBER" TO ENTER THE "VARIETY/COLOR"/ (DO NOT WRITE "ANY STANDARD COLOR" - this is so we may place birds into individual color classifications.) USE THE FIELD "TATOO/EAR NOTCH" TO ENTER THE LEG NUMBER.

- A. Entry Fees: Single Entries \$2.00, Trios \$2.00. Entries must be entered ONLINE by Friday, July 27, 2007 at 6:00 pm. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries through the online program will be made available at the Fairgrounds on:
- June 30th, 10-4 pm
July 11th, 12-6 pm
July 27th, 8-6 pm
- There is a \$3.00 fee per exhibitor to enter online and at the labs. Premiums will be paid out "in cash" during Fair week, dates and times will be available on entry date.
- B. Entries must be cooped Sunday, August 12, 2007, between 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m.
- C. Entries will be released on Sunday, August 19, 2007 at 7:00 p.m.
- D. Management will not be responsible for birds remaining after 8:30 p.m., Sunday, August 19, 2007. Any birds remaining after 9pm will be considered abandoned and disposed of appropriately. All ownership rights to these birds will be considered forfeited. Abandonment of birds will eliminate your ability to show birds at the Fair in the future.
- E. Birds that are sold may be released to buyer, with a receipt at 6:30 p.m., Sunday, August 19, 2007.
- F. Entry Limit: Entries are limited to two (2) per class per exhibitor/flock.
- G. Premiums: Exhibitors are awarded only two (2) monies per class per individual owner.
- H. All breeds of chickens, bantams, geese, ducks, turkeys and guineas recognized by the American Standard of Perfection and the Bantam Standard shall be the guide of the Judge. Judge's decision shall be final.
- I. Online Entries should state plainly band number (ENTER IT IN THE FIELD MARKED "TATTOO/EAR NOTCH"), sex, breed (ENTER IN THE FIELD MARKED "ANIMAL NAME"), variety (ENTER IN THE FIELD MARKED "REGISTRY NUMBER") and number of specimens.
- J. The term cock, hen, cockerel and pullet are thus defined. Cock and hen-birds are one year old or over. Cockerel and pullet-birds are under one year. Trios shall consist of one male and two females, with old and young competing separately.
- K. All birds must be banded and band number plainly marked online. Entries will not be accepted unless leg band numbers are online. (ENTER IT IN THE FIELD MARKED "TATTOO/EAR NOTCH")
- L. Disqualified birds, or birds not in cage at time of Judging, shall not be counted in total number of class in figuring premiums.
- M. No distinguishing marks will be permitted upon the coops until after the awards are made.
- N. All sales will be handled through the Superintendent: please pick up sale entry form when placing animals. Only animals entered may be sold. You will be issued a receipt with the buyer's name included for all Poultry sold. There will be a \$.50 handling fee on any animal sold, to use toward upgrading department equipment.
- O. No sales may take place on the premises through the department or privately to be used for suspected illegal purposes, such as cockfighting. Suspected private sellers will be warned. If a warning does not resolve the problem, other consequences may be sought, such as premiums for the entire flock being withheld and/or the exhibitor may be banned from future showing.

AMERICAN POULTRY ASSOCIATION CLUB MEET

A ribbon will be given to the best bird in each APA recognized breed. An APA medal will be awarded to the Champion bird in each of the following classes when ten or more birds are judged in the class.

- LARGE CHICKENS:** American, Asiatic, English Mediterranean, Continental and all other standard breeds.
BANTAMS: Modern Games, Old English Game, Single Comb Clean Legged, (Other than Game) Rose Comb Clean Legged, All other Combs Clean Legged, and Feather Legged.
DUCKS: Heavy, Medium and Light
TURKEYS: Bronze (all others compete in one class).
GUINEAS: Pearl (all others compete in one class).
 When ten or more are judged, a certificate will be given for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in each of the following classes: *Large Chickens, Bantams, Ducks, Geese, Turkeys and Guineas.*

All Judging shall be by the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection, copyright by the American Poultry Association, Inc., the Bantam Standard, and the National Pigeon Standard. The APA invites you to become a member. Adult dues are \$10.00 per year and \$25.00 for 3 years. Junior dues (for those 17 years and under) are \$5.00 per year. Dues will be accepted in the showroom, prior to judging or they may be sent to the AMERICAN POULTRY ASSOCIATION, Pat Horstman, PO Box 306, Burgettstown PA, 15021, www.amerpoultryassn.com. Adult members receive the yearbook and are eligible to earn Master Exhibitor points at sanctioned shows. All members receive the quarterly and are eligible for the awards at this show. Official ABA Sanctioned Show. American Bantam Association, P.O. Box 127, Augusta, NJ 07822. The ABA invites you to become a member, \$8.00 for one year or \$15.00 for two years.
