- A. Entry Fees: \$5.00 per head. Entries must be entered ONLINE by Friday, July 27, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.
- B. Entries must be in place Monday, August 13, 2007 by 8:00 p.m.
- C. Judging Schedule: Tuesday, August 14, 9:00 a.m.: Romney, Dorset, Southdown, Shropshire, Hampshire, North Country Cheviot, Montadale, Angora Goats, Wool, and any other registered breeds not listed. Wednesday, August 15, 9:00 a.m.: Suffolk, Cotswold, Border Cheviot, Romney Natural Color, Natural Color Other, Oxford, Lincoln, Jacob, Border Leicester and Trophy class.
- D. A Clinical Inspection may be made of all animals upon arrival. Any animals showing infectious or contagious disease will be refused entry.
- E. No animal shall compete in more than one (1) class, except as one of a herd or group.
- F. All Livestock Exhibitors are responsible for the neatness and cleanliness of the barn area occupied by their stock. All animals must be in place by 9:00 a.m. daily. All litter must be deposited in a place to be designated by the Superintendent in charge.
- G. Only Sheep and Angora Goats entered in the Sheep Department are allowed on the grounds during Fair, unless other arrangements have been made through the Department Superintendent or Exhibits Office.
- H. Sheep registered in more than one (1) registry will only be allowed to show under one registry for prize money. Decision of Section to be made by Sheep owner. All purebred Sheep, to be eligible to compete for premiums, shall have been recorded in the recognized books of record of their respective breeds and exhibitors must produce Certificate of registry at the request of the Superintendent in charge. All purebred Sheep under one year, competing for premiums, must be the offspring of a Ram and Ewe which are duly recorded. The owner of dam at time of service is recognized as breeder of the offspring.
- I. All Sheep and Angora Goats must be registered in breed section shown, papers must be available for inspection as animals are received, or during run of Fair.
- J. All entries will be released Sunday, August 19th. The time to be announced at a later date.
- K. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries through the online program will be made available at the Fairgrounds in June and July. There is a \$3.00 transaction fee per exhibitor to enter online and at the labs. Premiums will be paid out in cash during Fair week. Dates and times will be made available on entry day. If you are unable to pick up your premiums during Fair week, they will be mailed out by check on September 30, 2007. Lab dates are:
 - June 20th, 12-6 pm
 - June 30th, 10-4 pm
 - July 11th, 12-6 pm
 - July 27th, 8-6 pm
