CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- A. Online registration is required. Enter ONLINE at www.atthefair.com. Entry deadline is July 31, 2007 at midnight. Changes made to any entry can be made on the day entries are actually accepted. Entries are limited to residents living or owning land in Lane County, Oregon. Management reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered, to limit entries according to space available and to eliminate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- B. Exhibit entries will be accepted ONLINE ONLY through our Fair website. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries through the online program will be made available at the Fairgrounds in Meeting Room #2 on the following dates:
June 20th, 12-6 pm
June 30th, 10-4 pm
July 11th, 12-6 pm
July 28th, 10-4 pm
- C. If you are unable to bring your entry on entry day, please make arrangements to have someone bring it for you. We will NOT be accepting early entries prior to entry day.
- D. **Entry Limit:** An exhibitor may NOT make more than one (1) entry in any one class or twenty-four (24) entries in the Department.
- E. Bring entries at your own risk. Lane County Fair employees and/or their representatives are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- F. Premiums will be paid out in CASH during Fair week. Dates and times will be available on entry day. Premiums that are not picked up during Fair will be mailed by check on September 30, 2007.
- G. All entries need to be picked up on Monday, August 20th, between Noon and 7:00 pm. Any entries left after 7:00 pm will be disposed of accordingly.
- H. The Superintendent of the Textile Department and/or Judges reserve the right to reclassify and/or disqualify entries which are not properly classified.
- I. Entries **MUST** be the handiwork of the Exhibitor in the class in which it is being judged.
- J. Entries **MUST** be of some fiber content or will not be accepted in the Textile Department, i.e., plastic, wood, glass, etc. Recycle entries must be made from previously used items.
- K. **PRO-CLASS:** Anyone who receives pay from a vocation or hobby for an article they are entering. Exhibitor may not enter like article in open class.
- L. Entries consisting of more than one piece must be securely fastened together.
- M. Avoid heavy starching.
- N. All entries must have been completed and not shown within the last two (2) years at the Lane County Fair and cannot be shown more than once.
- O. Quilt entries **MUST** have a 4" wide continuous sleeve **sewn** on all quilt entries over 40" for hanging, otherwise they will not be accepted and/or judged.
- P. All pictures and wall hangings (excluding quilted wall hangings) must have **wire** attached across the back to allow for hanging, or they will not be accepted and/or judged.
- Q. Any names of exhibitors on entries, front and back, must be covered (no straight pins) for the judging process.
- R. Juniors 1, 2, 3 entries must have a 3" x 5" card attached stating age of exhibitor and describing the actual work done by the exhibitor.
- S. **BRING YOUR TEXTILE ENTRY TO THE NORTHWEST END OF THE EVENTS CENTER BETWEEN 10:00 A.M. AND 6:00 P.M. ON AUGUST 8, 2007.**
