JUDGING: AUGUST 18th, 19th, and 20th at 10:00 a.m.

- A. Entry Fees: \$5.00 per head.
- B. **There are NO online entries for livestock departments. Copies of blank entry forms and department information may be downloaded online or picked up at the Fair Business Office between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All entry forms, and fees must be MAILED IN or DROPPED OFF at the Fair Business Office, 796 West 13th, Eugene, OR 97402, and received by Friday, July 30th, at 6:00 p.m.** Opportunities for assistance in filling out your entry forms will be made available at the Fairgrounds on July 30th, between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.
- C. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 21st, between 11:00am and 5:00pm. **If premiums are not picked up, they will be mailed out by check no later than September 30th.**
- D. Entries must be in place Tuesday, August 17, 2010 by 8:00 p.m. Pens must be clean, clean water provided and animals properly fed and cared for every day.
- E. Milk Out: Wednesday, August 18th, 2010, to begin at 6:00 p.m. and check by 8:30 p.m.
- F. Judging will be held: Dairy Goats - JUNIOR SECTION Wednesday, August 18th, at 10:00 a.m.
SENIOR SECTION Thursday, August 19th, at 10:00 a.m.
Pygmy Goats - will be judged Friday August 20th after Showmanship
- G. **Entry Limit: Entries will be limited to three (3) per class per Exhibitor.**
- H. ADGA RULES WILL APPLY.
- I. Only Dairy and Pygmy Goats entered in the Goat Department are allowed on the grounds during Fair, unless other arrangements have been made through the Department Superintendent or Exhibits Office. No horned goats.
- J. All Dairy and Pygmy Goats must be registered in breed Section shown, and show owner's name (not herd name) with residence in Lane County, Oregon. All names included on one identification number constitute only one membership. Therefore only one exhibitor.
- K. Does Judged on Udder: To be milked in ring if Judge so desires. Entry must be pre-registered. **No ring side entries.**
- L. **NO** pending papers accepted. 30 day ownership.
- M. Two premiums in aged classes, and one premium in group class.
- N. No one allowed at the Judging table during the shows.
- O. The Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned.
- P. All entries will be released Sunday, August 22nd, after close of Fair (8pm). See Superintendent for move-out instructions.
