

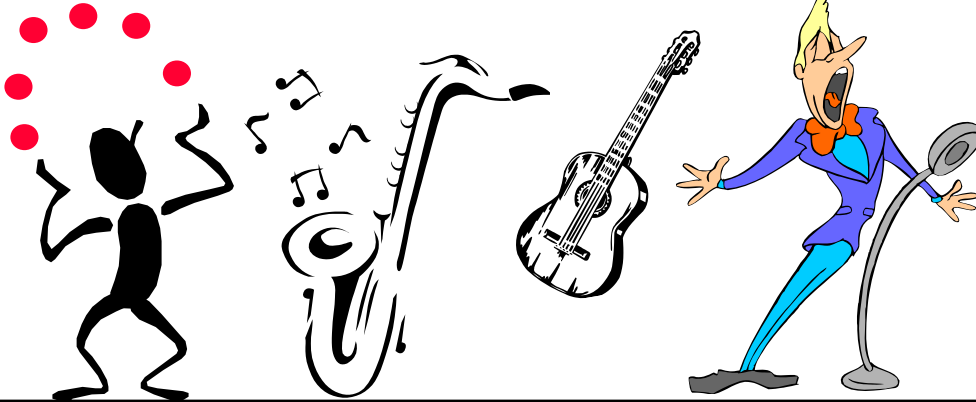

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY IS SUNDAY, JULY 24

FINALISTS WILL BE ANNOUNCED MONDAY, AUGUST 8

ALL PERFORMANCES WILL BE HELD THURSDAY, AUGUST 18 FROM 11:30AM-4PM AND WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT 5PM.

- Competition is open to Lane County residents only
- Previous first place winners of the Statewide Talent Contest may not compete the following two years, regardless of division or whether as part of the same or a different act
- There is no entry fee to the contest
- An individual, duet or group can perform. Bands are limited to three instruments they provide (no drum sets)
- All participants must be of amateur status, not belonging to a musician's union nor does talent provide any more than 50% of income
- One performance only, and should not exceed the 5 minute time limit for entire stage presence.
- There will be three age category 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners: 5-9 years, 10-17 years and 18 and over. Those who place 1st in their category will be eligible to compete in the Statewide Talent Contest
- **Individuals may participate in only one act. This will also prevent individuals from being included as participants in both age divisions. This rule has been adopted at the State level, as well.**
- Talent selections must be appropriate for family audiences.
- Fair admission is free for talent show participants
- There is no fairground parking charge
- Performers must provide their own accompaniment. A sound technician is available but participants must provide CDs ONLY. All CDs must be marked with name, track number and any stage instructions. Any CDs left by the participant will be discarded, so please remember to pick them up after your performance
- Recorded track may not include lead vocals, lip sync performances are not allowed
- Judging will be based on technique, style, talent and appearance
- There will only be one winner/winning group per place (1st-3rd) in each division. In the event of a tie for any of the three placements, the judges will use a consistently administered tie breaking calculation method.
- **Finalists will compete Thursday, August 18 from 11:30am-4pm. Winners will be announced at 5pm**
- Cash awards and awards are as follows:
 - 1st place winners** in all categories will receive \$100 and an award, advance to the State Fair preliminaries, admission for the winner to the State Fair, and one adult ticket to the State Fair for performers 18 and under. Parking also provided
 - 2nd and 3rd place winners** in all categories will receive awards
