CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

NOTE: Entries will close when pens are full, regardless of actual entry deadline. Get your entry forms in early!

- A. Entry Fees: \$5.00 per head.
- B. **There are NO online entries for livestock departments.** Copies of blank entry forms and department information may be downloaded online or picked up at the Fair Business Office between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All entry forms and fees for this department must be **RECEIVED** by Friday, July 15th at 6:00 p.m. They can be MAILED or DROPPED OFF at the Fair Business Office, 796 West 13th, Eugene OR 97402. Space is limited, get your entry forms in early. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 20th, between 11:00am and 3:00pm. **If premiums are not picked up, they will be mailed out by check no later than September 30th.**
- C. Entries must be in place Tuesday, August 16th, by 8:00 p.m.
- D. A Clinical Inspection may be made of all animals upon arrival. Animals showing infectious or contagious disease will be refused entry.
- E. No animal shall compete in more than one (1) class, except as one of a herd or group.
- F. All Livestock Exhibitors are responsible for the neatness and cleanliness of the barn area occupied by their stock. All animals must be in place by 9:00 a.m. daily. All litter must be deposited in a place to be designated by the Superintendent in charge.
- G. Only Sheep and Boer Goats entered in the Sheep Department are allowed on the grounds during Fair, unless other arrangements have been made through the Department Coordinator.
- H. Sheep and goats registered in more than one (1) registry will only be allowed to show under one registry for prize money. Decision of Section to be made by Sheep owner. All purebred Sheep, to be eligible to compete for premiums, shall have been recorded in the recognized books of record of their respective breeds and exhibitors must produce Certificate of registry at the request of the Coordinator in charge. All purebred Sheep under one year, competing for premiums, must be the offspring of a Ram and Ewe which are duly recorded. The owner of dam at time of service is recognized as breeder of the offspring.
- I. All animals must be registered in breed section shown, papers must be available for inspection as animals are received, or during Fair.
- J. All entries will be released Sunday, August 21st AFTER CLOSE OF FAIR. See Coordinator for move-out instructions.

*NO ENTRY FEE required if animal is entered in regular class. Exhibitors may enter until event begins but **MUST** use entry form. See Coordinator for entry forms if you have not pre-registered.

113. Showmanship—**UNREGISTERED ANIMALS ONLY** (Unregistered animals are ineligible to compete in any other Section or Class)

***Entry Fee \$5.00.** You must include this on your entry form to compete.
