CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

(Please read before entering!)

- A. Entries are limited to residents living or owning land in Lane County, Oregon. Management reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered, to limit entries according to space available and to eliminate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- B. Pre-registration is required and will be accepted ONLINE through our Fair website at www.atthefair.com or by mail. Entry deadline is July 31st, at midnight. Changes to any entry can be made on the day entries are actually accepted.
- C. Bring your entries to the Auditorium located at the Lane County Fairgrounds on Tuesday, August 16th, between 1:00pm and 7pm.
- D. If you are unable to bring your entry on entry day, please make arrangements to have someone bring it for you. We will **NOT** be accepting early entries prior to entry day.
- E. Lane County Fair employees/and or their representatives are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- F. Exhibitors are awarded only one (1) premium per class. Premiums will be paid out Saturday, August 20th, between 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Premiums that are not picked up during Fair will be mailed by check no later than September 30th. Monies for special awards will also be mailed.
- G. All entries need to be picked up on Monday, August 22nd between Noon and 6:00 p.m. Any entries left after 6:00 p.m. will become the Coordinator's responsibility for disposition.
- H. The Exhibitor must have grown all Exhibits in Sections 920 and 922. All Potted Plants must have been grown by, or in the possession of, the Exhibitor 60 days prior to Fair and all plants must have a water saucer.
- I. The Fair will furnish containers for cut flowers.
- J. Exhibitors are asked to **replace cut flowers as often as necessary for the duration of the Fair, at least once.**
- K. Artificial flowers or foliage is excluded.
- L. Exhibitors are not to remove any exhibit before the end of the Fair without permission from the Department Coordinator.
- M. **ABSOLUTELY NO SAND ANYWHERE IN FLORAL DEPARTMENT.**
- N. **Arrangements:** Exhibitors must furnish their own containers labeled on the bottom with owners name. Arranger may place own arrangement. Committee will assist. **Arrangements must be kept fresh until the close of the Fair. Please plan on replacing flower arrangements at least once.** Arrangements not conforming to schedule will be used for display only. Foliage is permitted in all classes unless otherwise specified. Accessories are permitted. Only **one design per class allowed in Design Section.**
- O. All entries in Section 920 should be shown with their own attached leaves. **Please write the name on entry card, if at all possible.**

SECTION

921 Potted Plants

Not open to commercial growers—gallon size plastic or pottery containers and/or baskets—no hanging baskets or huge tubs, please!

CLASS:

1. Rex Begonias—featuring foliage
2. Martha Washington Geraniums—any color
3. Geraniums-any other types; scented, novelty, ivy etc.
4. African Violet—one crown
5. Cactus and/or succulents, one plant per container
6. Cactus and/or succulents, multiple plants per container
7. Indoor plant, featuring bloom, pot under 6"
8. Indoor plant, featuring bloom, pot over 6"
9. Indoor plant, featuring foliage pot under 6"
10. Indoor plant, featuring foliage, pot over 6"
11. Indoor Ferns, all types, enter in this class only
12. Planters, mix of 3 or more different in suitable container up to 12" max, must have water saver or provisions for watering

SECTION

922 Junior Section

18 years of age and under

CLASS:

1. Asters, 1 bloom
2. Cosmos, 3 stems
3. Dahlias, over 6", 1 bloom
4. Dahlias, under 6", 1 bloom
5. Marigolds, petite, 3 stems alike
6. Petunia, 3 stems
7. Zinnia, small, 3 blooms alike or assorted
8. Zinnia, large, 1 bloom
9. Cut flower, large, any other, 1 stem
10. Cut flower, small, any other, 3 stems alike
11. Gladiola, 1 spike
12. Sunflowers, 1 bloom, any color

SECTION

923 Garden Clubs - No Premiums Awarded

1 – Floral Designs – “In Memory of Alfaretta Spores”. Choose your style. Use fresh flowers and foliage with an emphasis on pink and purple. To be placed on white pedestals. Call Coordinator to pre-register and for further details. Designs must be kept fresh by the club until the Fair closes on Sunday.

2 – Garden Angels – “Looking Out for Alfaretta’s Garden”. 3’ - 4’ tall figure in a 3’ x 3’ floor space; provide own staging; can be constructed from any material and must include some plant material.

Garden Clubs will also sponsor a hands-on experience with Floral Arrangements for children on Kids Day and Seniors on Senior Day. Other Demonstrations to be announced.

Entries will be judged as follows:

(Score sheet given to each club)

- Conformance.....20 points**
- Design.....42 points**
- Distinction.....16 points**
- Creativity and expression.....22 points**

SECTION

924 Open Class

Open to anyone. Judges and professionals must enter this class only.

CLASS:

1. Waves of Fun: Featuring water as part of design and using fresh flowers.
2. It’s a Stretch: Use 2 containers with one appearing to be stretched from the other; your choice of fresh and/or dried materials.
3. Into the Woods: Feature weathered wood with fresh flowers and foliages.
4. Fun with Metal: Abstract Creative Design featuring metal (non traditional style); your choice of fresh and/or dried materials.
5. Play it Again: Designers Choice using recycled or repurposed materials; dried materials.
6. Fantasy in Miniature: Miniature design, not to exceed 5” in any direction. All dried.

SECTION

925 Advanced Amateur

Open to those who have won more than 5 blue ribbons.

The Exhibitor must make Designs and need not have grown plant materials.

CLASS:

1. Red Light: Mass design of fresh flowers and foliages featuring the color red.
2. Green Light: All foliage design, using many shades of greenery, including herbs.
3. Second Time Around: Use a container which you have recycled or repurposed; all dried plant material.
4. History Repeats Itself: Choose an era to reflect and include the time period on a 3” x 5” card with design; your choice of accessories and materials.
5. My Alma Mater: Designer’s choice, include a 3” x 5” card with school name and colors by your design.
6. Miniature Magic: Miniature design, not to exceed 5” in any direction. All dried.

SECTION

926 Novice

Those who have won 5 or fewer blue ribbons.

The Exhibitor must make Designs and need not have grown plant materials.

CLASS:

1. Fun with the Past: May use fresh and/or dried materials.
2. Foliage For Fun: All foliage design, may combine herbs with other garden foliage.
3. Reduce, Reuse, Recycle: Use a container which you have recycled or repurposed; your choice of fresh and/or dried plant material.
4. Let’s Entertain: Design for a table centerpiece; include the dishes it will be used with.
5. Fun in the Garden: A design incorporating fruits and/or veggies from the garden; fresh and/or dried materials.
6. Tiny Gems: Miniature design, not to exceed 5” in any direction.



SECTION

927 Juniors

Grades 7 through 12

The Exhibitor must make Designs and need not have grown plant material.

CLASS:

1. Go Ducks: Use yellow and green colors in design with fresh flowers.
2. Go Beavs: Use orange and black colors in design with fresh flowers.
3. It's Fun to Read: Feature your favorite book with a floral design that goes with it.
4. Eating Right: Decorate a vegetable any way you wish. Give it a name!

SECTION

928 Juniors

Grades K through 6

The Exhibitor must make Designs and need not have grown plant material.

CLASS:

1. Flowers are Fun: Use a basket to show off your favorite flowers.
2. I Like to Read: Feature your favorite book with a floral design that goes with it.
3. It's a Tea Party: Use a tea cup for your floral design and stage it on a small tray.
4. Playing Dress Up: Decorate a vegetable any way you wish. Give it a name!

SECTION

929 Table Settings

"You must provide your own table". Size cannot exceed 36" maximum. No Silverware.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

Tray tables will be staged on 8' tables, and maximum room for staging is 24" square.

The Exhibitor must make Designs and has choice of all materials used and need not have grown them.

CLASS:

1. Casual, Informal for 2— Examples: Patio or tailgate party; Alfresco; children's party, baby shower, etc. Your choice of accessories, flowers, tablecloth, etc. Entry must include a menu with the theme at the top.
2. Semi-Formal for 2— Examples: Wedding reception; anniversary; engagement parties, graduation, luncheons, etc. Your choice of accessories, tablecloth, flowers, foliages, etc. Entry must include a menu with the theme at the top.
3. Tray Tables— State if for breakfast, tea, or lunch, etc. Entry must include a menu with the theme at the top
