CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE NOTE: The entry day has changed. SUNDAY is the day you bring your entries in!

BASIC ENTRY RULES:

- A. Entries are limited to residents living or owning land in Lane County, Oregon.
- B. Management reserves the right to reject any exhibit, to limit entries according to space available, and to eliminate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- C. Lane County Fair employees and/or their representatives are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

PRE-REGISTRATION:

- D. Pre-registration is required and will be accepted ONLINE through our Fair website at www.atthefair.com **or by mail.**
- E. Entry deadline is July 31, at midnight. Changes to any entry can be made on the day entries are actually accepted.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- F. ONE (1) ENTRY PER CLASS and NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE (25) TOTAL ENTRIES IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- G. PLEASE BRING EXHIBITS ON DISPOSABLE PLATES INDIVIDUALLY COVERED WITH PLASTIC WRAP.
- H. Return of plates or pans cannot be guaranteed.

ENTRY DAY : SUNDAY, August, 14th, 2011 — THIS IS A NEW DATE, SO PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF IT.

- I. Bring entries to Meeting Room #4 (**this is a new location**) located at the southwest end of the Convention Center.
- J. Hours are 10am to 6pm. We will not accept entries before 10am or after 6pm. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- K. Please make arrangements to have someone bring your item for you if you are not available during hours.
- L. Exhibitors with 20 or more entries, received by 3pm on entry day, will receive two (2) fair tickets.

RELEASE DAY: Monday, August 22nd, 2011.

- M. Pick up your entries between Noon and 6:00 p.m. on Monday, August 22nd. Any ribbons, comment cards or entries left after 6:00 p.m. will be forfeited.

PREMIUMS:

- N. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 20th, between 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- O. If premiums are not picked up they will be mailed out by check no later than September 30th.

GENERAL INFORMATION - ADULTS, JUNIORS, YOUNGSTERS:

- P. ALL exhibitors use the same class numbers, only section numbers differ.
- Q. All entries must be homemade by the Exhibitor and must not contain packaged mixes, except for Creative Cake Mix Class. Only one (1) entry per recipe will be accepted.
- R. All baked goods (with the exception of gift packs and decorated cakes) will be disposed of at the conclusion of Fair.
- S. Limit the size of article to 12" high and 12" wide, except decorated cakes and gift packs.
- T. Entry Tags will be computer generated from your pre-registration of the entry.

YOUNGSTERS (Age 7-10) AND JUNIORS (Age 11-17):

- U. Please indicate age of Youngster or Junior on registration forms.
- V. Youngsters may only enter in the following sections: 501, 502, 504, 505, 506
- W. Youngsters are not eligible for sweepstakes.
- X. See general Information for further guidelines.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

- 1. All Sweepstakes winners are awarded a Rosette Ribbon by the Fair Board.
- 2. Winners are posted during Fair week.
- 3. Points are to be counted as follows: 1st Award=5 points, 2nd Award=3 points, 3rd Award=1 point. In case of a tie, the Exhibitor with the most Blue Ribbons shall be the winner.
- 4. **Sweepstake winners are eligible to win every three years.**
- 5. Best of Show: Will be chosen from all first place entries **except for Sections 304,404, 504, 307, 407, and all contests.**
- 6. Only Adult and Juniors are eligible.

4. Must fit on 9" x 9" base and no higher than 12".
5. Entries will be judged on creativity and appearance.
6. All entries receive ONE free fair ticket.
7. No monetary awards will be given for this contest.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRY

- Open to any individual who is a Lane County, Oregon resident; one entry per person. All ages may enter but there will be no "junior" division.
- Entered pie must include at least 60% Oregon berries in the filling. It does not have to be a "traditional" two crust berry pie.
- A receipt for the purchase of fresh, frozen, or canned Oregon blackberries (including but not limited to Kotata, Chester, Sylvan, Black Diamond) and Marionberries may be used and must accompany the entered pie.
- Wild blackberries are not valid varieties as this is a contest to promote Oregon cultivated blackberries. Home grown cultivated blackberries must be identified by variety and as home grown.
- The entire pie must be submitted for judging in a disposable aluminum pie pan.
- Recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with the entry. It must be typed or printed on one side of an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of paper and must list all ingredients, quantities, and preparation instructions. Name, address, and phone number must be included on the back side of all pages.
- All recipes submitted will become the property of the Oregon Raspberry & Blackberry Commission and may be used as part of their public relations efforts in promoting Oregon berries.
- Judges decision is final.
