CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- A. Entries are limited to residents living or owning land in Lane County, Oregon. Management reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered, to limit entries according to space available and to eliminate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- B. Pre-registration is required and will be accepted ONLINE through our Fair website at www.atthefair.com or by mail. Entry deadline is July 31st at midnight. Changes to any entry can be made on the day entries are actually accepted.
- C. **Entry Limit:** one (1) entry in any one class or twenty-four (24) entries in the Department.
- D. **BRING YOUR TEXTILE ENTRY TO THE ATRIUM, LOCATED IN THE CENTER OF THE EVENTS CENTER, BETWEEN 10:00 A.M. AND 6:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, AUGUST 8TH.**
- E. If you are unable to bring your entry on entry day, please make arrangements to have someone bring it for you. We will NOT be accepting entries prior to or after entry day.
- F. Lane County Fair employees and/or their representatives are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- G. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 20th, between 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. If premiums are not picked up they will be mailed by check no later than September 30th.
- H. All entries need to be picked up on Monday, August 22nd, between Noon and 6:00 p.m. Any entries left after 6:00 p.m. will become Coordinator's responsibility for disposition.
- I. The Coordinator of the Textile Department and/or Judges reserve the right to reclassify and/or disqualify entries which are not properly classified.
- J. Entries **MUST** be the handiwork of the Exhibitor in the class in which it is being judged.
- K. Entries **MUST** be of some fiber content or will not be accepted in the Textile Department, i.e., plastic, wood, glass, etc. Recycle entries must be made from previously used items. **No sharp objects may be used that might be harmful to the handler.**
- L. **PRO-CLASS:** Anyone who receives pay from a vocation or hobby for an article they are entering. Exhibitor may not enter like article in open class.
- M. Entries consisting of more than one piece must be securely fastened together.
- N. All entries must be clean and free of odor and pet hair. Avoid heavy starching.
- O. All entries must have been completed and not shown within the last two (2) years at the Lane County Fair and cannot be shown more than once.
- P. Quilt entries that are over 40" **MUST** have a 4" wide continuous sleeve **sewn** on for hanging, otherwise they will not be accepted.
- Q. All pictures and wall hangings (excluding quilted wall hangings) must have **wire** attached across the back to allow for hanging, or they will not be accepted.
- R. Any names of Exhibitors on entries, front and back, must be covered (no straight pins) for the judging process.
- S. Juniors 1, 2, 3 entries must have a 3" x 5" card attached stating age of exhibitor and describing the actual work done by the exhibitor.
