- A. Entry Fees: \$3.00 per animal per class.
- B. **There are NO online entries for livestock departments.** Copies of blank entry forms and department information may be downloaded online or picked up at the Fair Office between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. All entry forms, registration papers and fees must be MAILED in or dropped off at the Fair Business Office, 796 West 13th, Eugene OR 97402, by Friday, July 30th, at 6:00 p.m. Opportunities for assistance in filling out your entry forms will be made available at the Fairgrounds on July 30th, between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.
- C. Premiums: Exhibitors are awarded no more than two (2) premium monies per class. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 21st, between 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. **If premiums are not picked up, they will be mailed out by check no later than September 30th.**
- D. Entry Limit: Four (4) per class per exhibitor.
- E. Entries must be in place Sunday, August 15th, between 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m.
- F. Animals that are sold may be released to buyer, with a receipt at 8:00 p.m. Sunday, August 22nd.
- G. The show will be governed by the latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. Entry implies acceptance of said rules.
- H. All feeding and care will be handled by the Superintendent.
- I. All livestock shall be the property of the exhibitor and shall so appear on the records of their respective pedigree. Transfers must be complete, showing 30 days ownership.
- J. All Rabbits must be properly earmarked in the left ear and this number listed on entry form. If you do not have a Tattoo marker, the Superintendent will do it for you on Sunday, August 15th. The charge will be \$1.50 per animal.
- K. Awards will be placed on breeds recognized by the Standard of Perfection of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association.
- L. Ear number substitutions in same class, same sex will be allowed only until THURSDAY, AUGUST 12th, 12:00 NOON. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS AFTER THAT TIME. Call the Fair Business Office at (541) 682-7338 with substitutions.
- M. Coop card markers will be available for those Exhibitors wishing to carry their own animals on show day. Carriers will be provided for those not marked.
- N. A Clinical Inspection will be made of all animals upon arrival. Any animals showing infectious or contagious disease will be refused entry. All pregnant animals will be refused entry. For all animals that are refused entry, entry fees will be forfeited.
- O. All stock is entered and shown at the risk of the owner. The Fair will not be responsible for loss by fire, theft or otherwise, but will exercise all reasonable vigilance in the care of exhibits until Sunday, August 22nd, 2010 at 9:00 p.m. After 9:00 pm Sunday, any animals remaining in the barn become the Superintendent's responsibility for disposition.
- P. The sales will be handled through the Superintendent, please pick up sales forms when placing animals. Only pedigreed animals entered or on exhibit in the rabbit barn may be sold. There will be a \$1.00 handling fee on any animal sold. Please give pedigree and completed sales forms to the Superintendent. You will be issued a receipt for all animals sold with your sale price.
- Q. No animals under 8 weeks of age will be allowed.
- R. All junior animals will be weighed upon arrival or at anytime during the Fair. They will be sent home if they are underweight. Proper weight is determined by the individual breed of the animal as specified by the American Rabbit Breeder Association's Standard of Perfection. For animals that are sent home, entry fees will be forfeited. **Once an animal has completed the check-in process, it may not leave the building until released.**
- S. ONLY LANE COUNTY RESIDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW/EXHIBIT/SELL IN THE RABBIT DEPARTMENT.
- T. Only Rabbits entered in the Rabbit Department are allowed on the grounds during Fair, unless other arrangements have been made through the Department Superintendent or Exhibits Office.
- U. All Entries will be released on Sunday, August 22nd, AFTER CLOSE OF FAIR. See Superintendent for move out instructions.

3. ROASTER: Under 6 months of age. Minimum weight over 5 pounds. Max weight 8 pounds.
4. STEWER: 6 months of age and over. Minimum weight over 8 pounds.
5. FRYER FUR: Must also be entered in a Fryer Class to compete in Fur Class.
