

**2010 LANE COUNTY FAIR  
EXHIBITOR CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS  
AUGUST 18 – 22**

The Superintendent will issue you your parking spot and your camping permit. This permit must be prominently displayed on trailer or motor home at all times. Trailers or motor homes without permits are subject to towing. All units must be self contained.

All campground users must keep their space litter free and in a sanitary condition.

No dumping or dripping of gray or black water.

Bikes, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters and ATV's are prohibited from the fairgrounds during the fair.

Glass containers can not be taken out of camping units and brought into the general fairgrounds or barn area.

No alcohol shall be brought on to the Fairgrounds unless prior authorization is obtained from the Fair Manager.

No person shall consume any alcohol while on the Fairgrounds unless such person is within an area designated by the Fair Board.

No alcohol or illegal substance will be allowed in the camper area. Minors found in possession of alcohol or any illegal substance will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

No person shall possess, while on the Fairgrounds, or bring into the Fairgrounds any guns, knives (having a blade longer than three inches, numb chucks, fireworks, explosives or any other lethal weapons.

No person shall engage in fighting, use of obscene and abusive language, or conduct himself or herself in a disorderly manner while on the Fairgrounds.

Rowdiness, profanity or vandalism will not be tolerated. Fair management reserves the right to dismiss any offender immediately for reasons satisfactory to itself, without refund.

Sawdust for cattle and horses will be piled next to the Ice Arena across from the horse barn.

Animal waste can be deposited in a container located at the south end of horse stalls.

In case of emergency the west gate will be manned 24 hours.

The south and west gates will be available for vehicles to enter the grounds at 6:30 am. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 10:00 am. All vehicles must be operated safely, quietly, and obey all traffic and parking regulations. Speed limit is 5 mph.

All person(s) in the vehicle, including the driver, are required to have a fair ticket to get through the gate.

Showers will be available 6:30 am to 10:30 am in the Ice Center.

Camper check-in will be Monday, August 16<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. Contact the Superintendent for your location.

No Excessive noise is allowed before 7am or after 11pm.

Any violation of the camper regulations may result in withdrawal of camping privileges.
