**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- A. Entries are limited to residents living or owning land in Lane County, Oregon. Management reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered, to limit entries according to space available and to eliminate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- B. Pre-registration is required and will be accepted ONLINE through our Fair website [www.atthefair.com](http://www.atthefair.com) or by mail. Entry deadline is July 31st, at midnight. Changes to any entry can be made on the day entries are actually accepted. Opportunities for assistance in entering entries will be made available at the Fairgrounds on July 30th, between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.
- C. **ENTRY LIMIT: ONE (1) PER CLASS, NO MORE THAN SIXTY-FIVE (65) TOTAL ENTRIES IN THE DEPARTMENT. Bring entries to the Auditorium on Saturday, August 14th, between 10:00 a.m.-6 p.m. Those entering 20 or more entries must be in by 2:00 p.m.**
- D. If you are unable to bring your entry on entry day, please make arrangements to have someone bring it for you. We will NOT be accepting early entries.
- E. Lane County Fair employees and/or their representatives are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- F. Premiums will be paid out on Saturday, August 21st, between 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If premiums are not picked up they will be mailed out by check no later than September 30th.
- G. All entries need to be picked up on Monday, August 23rd, between Noon and 6:00 p.m. Any entries left after 6:00 p.m. will become the Superintendent's responsibility for disposition.
- H. All entries in this department must be home prepared and canned within one year of the opening date of the Fair this year and must be entered for competition in the name of the maker.
- I. Entries must be in brand-name mason canning jars with new rings. Accepted only as follows:
  - >Soft Spreads 1/2 pint and pint mason jars
  - >Clear Fruit Juices in 1/2 gallon, quart, and pint mason jars
  - >Fruits and Vegetables pint and quart mason jars only
  - >Lemon Curd 1/2 pint Mason jars only
  - >Pickles in pint and quart mason jars
  - >Fish and shellfish PINT AND 1/2 PINT Mason jars only
  - >Meats, poultry, and game meats 1/2 pint and pint only. Includes all broths and sauces with meats, poultry or game meats.
- J. Certain classes require recipes to be attached to the jar. Each page of the recipe must have the exhibitor's name printed on it. Rubberband the recipe around the jar firmly.
- K. **All canned exhibits MUST be processed according to current standards.** No paraffin seals. (you may obtain a bulletin from OSU Extension for a guide). Call 682-4243 for questions. **Summer Squash** is no longer an accepted product for home canning, except when used for pickles. **Lemon Curd in a half pint container**, is the only dairy that is accepted at this time. OSU Extension recipe must be attached and used to preserve. **NOTICE: Open Kettle Canning Methods and Jam & Jelly Jar Inversions** for sealing are not a currently accepted standard in canning. SEE REQUIREMENTS AND DIRECTIONS FOR BALL® & KERR® on next page.
- L. **Process all jams and jellies in Boiling Water Bath as follows:**

**Times & Elevations**

- At least 10 minutes at sea level to 1000 ft.
- At least 10 minutes for 1001 ft. to 6000 ft.
- At least 15 minutes for 6001 ft. to 8000 ft.

- M. Judges may or may not open any or all exhibits. It is up to the individual judge of each section to choose if they will taste an exhibit.
- N. Adults and Juniors are to use the same Class Numbers. Only the Section number differs.
- O. Entry Tags will be computer generated with the pre-registration of your entry form. However, Canning Labels may be picked up at the Fair Office prior to entry day.
- P. **Entries of 25 or more per person will receive a free pass to the fair!**
- Q. Names of the Adult and Junior Sweepstakes winners will be posted on Thursday, during Fair.
- R. **Special Awards:** Both Adult and Junior Sweepstakes are awarded a Rosette Ribbon by the Fair Board to be counted as follows:  
 1st Award=5 pts      2nd Award=3 pts      3rd Award=1pt.  
 Tie breaker is Exhibitor with the most Blue Ribbon wins. Sweepstake winners from 2006 year forward will not be allowed to win until the fourth year from their winning date. The winner of 2006 shall be allowed to win "Sweeps" in 2010. This rule change applies only to first place "Sweeps" position. Second and third runner-up are open.
